On Broadway: The Evolution of Dance on the Broadway Stage



“On Broadway” explores the evolution of dance on the Broadway stage from the Zeigfield years in the early 1900s to the present day era of the Jukebox Musical. Visit the replica of the famous Sardi’s restaurant along with a new gallery of local children’s artwork inspired by Broadway. Also, walk through our new addition: the backstage area of a Broadway theater!

Kenn Duncan

This exhibit contains selections from Kenn Duncan’s “Red Shoes” and another black and white series. It features the photographs of such influential dancers as Gregory Hines, Mikhail Baryshnikov, Chita Rivera and Liliane Montevecchi, all wearing red shoes in their own creative and unique style.

Art in the Foyer

This season’s Art in the Foyer exhibit will feature the work of New York City based photographer Paul Kolnik. Twenty of his original images from his years photographing dance and Broadway will be on display featuring photographs of Jerome Robbins and George Balanchine as well as scenes from Broadway shows such as The Producers, Sweet Charity, and Chicago. This exhibit displays biographies, memorabilia, music and photography from the inception of the world renowned ballet company through daughter companies such as the New York City Ballet.
